1	 □ Over-the-counter medication recommended for those without allergy or contraindication: □ Ibuprofen (aka Advil, Motrin) – take three tablets (200mg each) every 6 hours with food. Do not exceed 2400mg □ Acetaminophen (aka Aleve, Tylenol) – take one tablet (325mg or 500mg) every 6 hours.
